We are still going through a civil war in Syria, we hear the difficult news every day but we can be witnesses for the Lord's work with us.


The good news that we are continuing in the deaf meetings, and the deaf are very excited to know more about our God.

The difficult war was a problem and challenge for us and for the deaf too, the fear from shells and explosions was the reason for the difficulty of movement in Damascus, also the weak economy and the spread of disease due to lack of water and electricity for many days, all these were the challenge to still live in Syria.

Despite that, we were as a church with encouraged by the Pastor Edward to continue the vision with all the joy and we saw the Lord was with us all the time.

About the funds, we have received 250\$ a month from you and the monthly salary for us too, during the last three months, we were able to prepare the dinner for the deaf twice a month, and a little to the deaf children too.
