Prices are PER PERSON. Booking includes: accommodation, conference registration, meals, airport transport, day tour & t-shirt.

- Single room (1 person) + conference + meals **\$860 (AUD) per person**

DMI is responsible ONLY for the management of attendees' accommodation and conference bookings for the duration of the conference. Meals are included in the accommodation and conference packages.

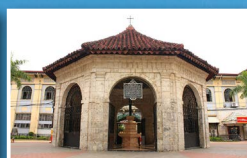
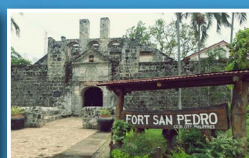
All flights, visas, travel insurance, transport, vaccinations or additional accommodation are **the responsibility of attendees.**
